KNOW THE SIGNS

KNOW WHAT TO DO

If a person is vomiting

Keep from choking
Prevent drowning in toilet
Keep person from harming themselves

Is hard to awaken or
has passed out

Turn on their left side
to avoid choking on
vomit
Keep person awake
Call 911

Is not breathing

Call 911
Do CPR (if trained)

Cannot be awakened
Has blue lips or nail beds

Call 911

★★★ **ALWAYS STAY WITH THE PERSON** ★★★

KNOW THE FACTS

- It is illegal for anyone under 21 to purchase, consume, possess, or transport any alcohol, liquor, malt, or brewed beverages.
- It is illegal for anyone under 21 to lie about their age or to carry a false I.D. card to obtain alcohol.
- Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) continues to rise even after a person stops drinking.
- Hazards resulting from alcohol abuse include vehicle crashes, rape, sexually transmitted diseases, and accidental death due to drowning and falls.
